- Future and Career Plans
- Letters of recommendation
- Completion of the Application (completeness and following instructions)

Our scholarships are one time cash awards of \$1,000.00 each. The successful applicant will be paid after the successful completion of one academic quarter/semester, upon providing Kiwanis a copy of your grades.

To be considered for this scholarship you will be required to return:

- The scholarship application
- The one page volunteer service form
- A one page statement of career plans
- A one page statement of financial information
- Two recommendations.
 - One from a teacher or school counselor
 - One from a community member who is not a school employee
 - Each recommendation will contain a completed recommendation form and a one page comment section with a personal recommendation.
